Thank you parents and school family for all gifts to teachers and staff! Their smiles and cheerfulness are priceless!

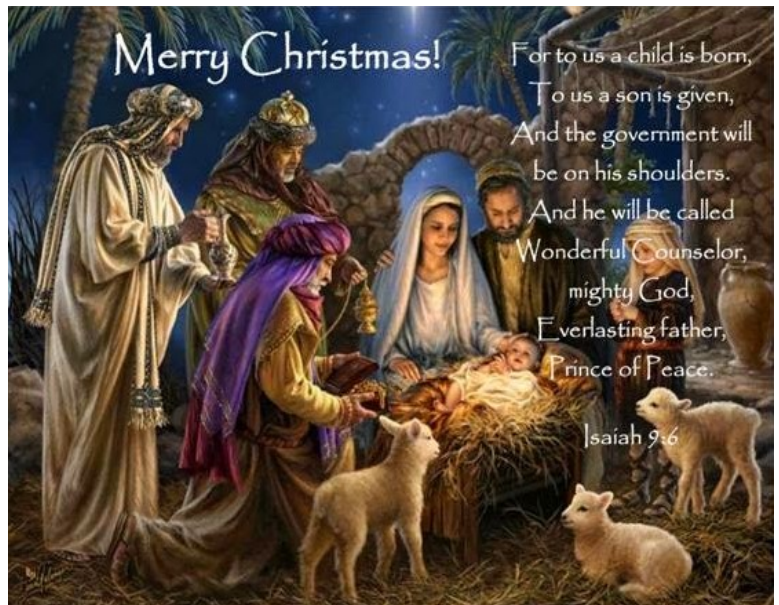

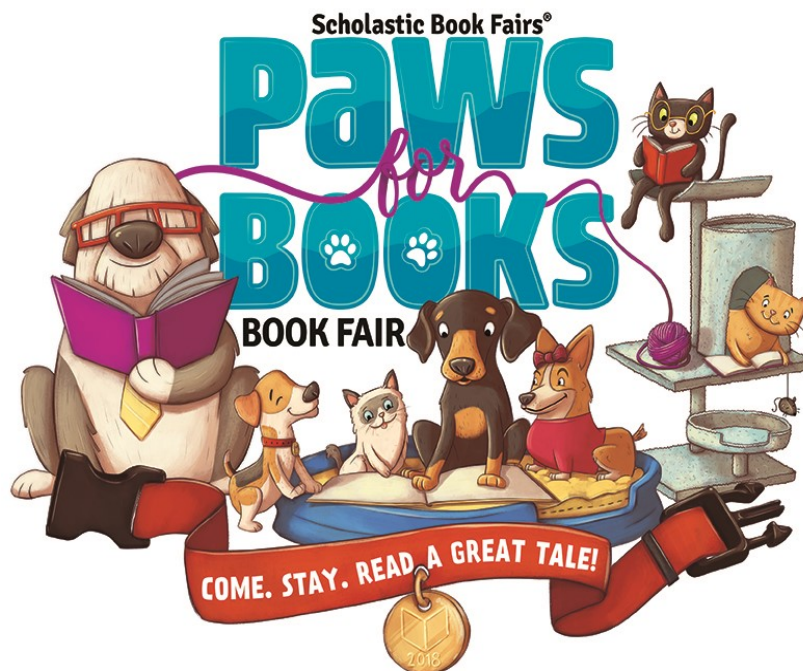
