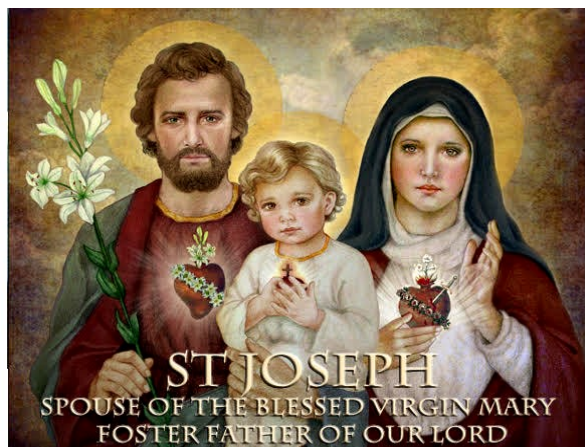

Saint Joseph – Tuesday, 3/19 was the feast of St. Joseph, spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Bible states Joseph was a "just" man. It means that God, the all-holy one, so transforms a person the individual shares somehow in God's own holiness, and hence it is really "right" for God to love him or her. The Bible means he was one who was completely open to all God wanted to do for him. He became holy by opening himself totally to God. Think of the kind of love with which he wooed and won Mary, and the depth of the love they shared during their marriage. It is no contradiction of Joseph's manly holiness he decided to divorce Mary when she was found to be with child. The important words of the Bible are he planned to do this "quietly" because he was "a righteous man, yet unwilling to expose her to shame" (Matthew 1:19). The just man was simply, joyfully, wholeheartedly obedient to God—in marrying Mary, in naming Jesus, in shepherding the precious pair to Egypt, in bringing them to Nazareth, in the undetermined number of years of quiet faith and courage. The Bible tells us nothing of Joseph in the years after the return to Nazareth except the incident of finding Jesus in the Temple (Luke 2:41–51). Perhaps this can be taken to mean God wants us to realize that the holiest family was like every other family, the circumstances of life for the holiest family were like those of every family, so when Jesus' mysterious nature began to appear, people couldn't believe he came from such humble beginnings: "Is he not the carpenter's son? Saint Joseph is the Patron Saint of carpenters, families, and fathers. (franciscanmedia.org)
