

Saint Joseph – The feast of St. Joseph, spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary was March 19. The Bible states Joseph was a "just" man. It means that God, the all-holy one, so transforms a person that they share somehow in God's own holiness, and hence it is really "right" for God to love him or her. The Bible means he was one who was completely open to all God wanted to do for him. He became holy by opening himself totally to God. Think of the kind of love with which he wooed and won Mary, and the depth of the love they shared during their marriage. It is no contradiction of Joseph's manly holiness he decided to divorce Mary when she was found to be with child. The important words of the Bible are he planned to do this "quietly" because he was "a righteous man, yet unwilling to expose her to shame". The just man was simply, joyfully, wholeheart-edly obedient to God—in marrying Mary, in naming Jesus, in shepherding the precious pair to Egypt, in bring-ing them to Nazareth, in the undetermined number of years of quiet faith and courage. Registration for new students in grades 4K-8 may be completed at the school office during the hours of 8:00 am-3:00 pm.

Parents of new students must present birth certificate, baptism certificate (if applicable), Social Security card and their child's immunization records at the time of registration.

A student is eligible for admission into 4K if he/she has reached the age of 4 on or before September 1. A child is eligible for admission into Kindergarten if he/she has reached the age of 5 on or before September 1. A child is eligible for admission into first grade if he/she has reached the age of six years on or before September 1.
